Note to Customer,

- Android device only
- The device must have NFC
- You can use windows to move the file to the device with USB cables, but it will only open the file on Android OS.
- Sometimes you can email the file to the device and open the (.APK) application file.
- Driver need-not be powered with line voltage, but it can be
- NFC sticker on the side of the driver is the antenna location.
- Most Android devices with NFC have a sticker on their NFC antenna location
- Touch the number on the screen example 1050 mA
- When you touch the number, a key pad appears
- Type in 850 (for example)
- Press "write"
- Touch the antennas
- You will get a vibration in the phone and an audible sound (like receiving an email)
 - This is confirmation the programing happened.
- You can press the "Read" button to see the mA setting
 - You must touch the antennas to get the data
 - Again, you will get a vibration and sound
